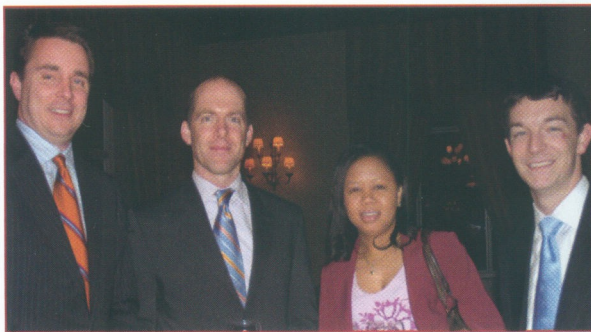


NEW DESTINY HOUSING CORPORATION HONORS EFFORTS OF INDIVIDUALS AND COMPANIES

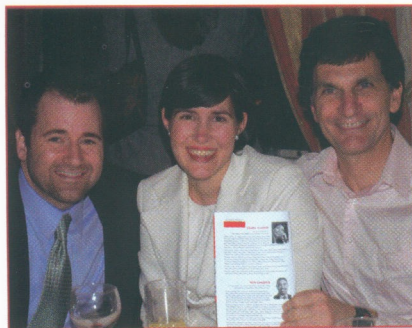

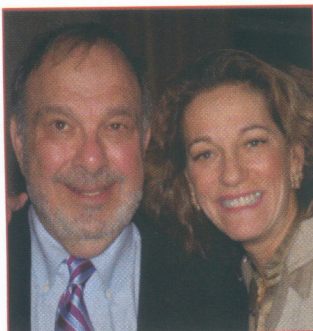
